

How to Log in to EpicCare Link

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This guide includes information to help you log in to EpicCare Link, including browser requirements and how to log in.

Browser, system, and connection requirements

You must use one of the following Internet browsers to access EpicCare Link:

- On the Windows operating system:
 - Internet Explorer version 11
 - Firefox version 45 or later
 - Chrome version 50 or later
 - Microsoft Edge version 79 or later
- On the Macintosh operating system:
 - Firefox version 45 or later
 - Chrome version 50 or later
 - Safari version 9 or later

EpicCare Link can also be accessed by iPads running iOS 9 or later using the Safari browser and Android tablets using the Chrome browser. The native Android browser and other third-party browsers are not supported. The Chrome browser on iOS is also not supported.

To function properly with your web application, a browser must be able to accept cookies, and it must be enabled to run JavaScript. These are enabled by default when you install the supported browsers, so they're supported unless you have explicitly disabled them.

EpicCare Link requires a minimum screen resolution of 1024x768 pixels. We recommend that you use a high-speed Internet connection to achieve the best system speed and performance.

Password Creation Tips

- Passwords must be unique per individual
- Passwords must be at least 15 characters, including numbers, letters, and special characters
- Do not use single dictionary words, *especially* including Trinity, Spring, Summer, Fall, Winter, Names of Months, etc.
- Consider phrases like:
 - o Erika's Password 15 Reset
 - T0getherCar3 pw 4 @Susan

Note: If you are unable to reset your own password, this may be due to a block on your account. Please contact your administrator/coordinator at your facility for assistance.



How do I log in?

- 1. Open your web browser and go to https://epic-ecl.trinity-health.org/EpicCareLink/common/epic_login.asp
- 2. Enter the user ID and temporary password that you received for EpicCare Link.



- 3. You will be prompted to change your password, set up challenge questions, and also enroll in two factor authentication.
- 4. Follow the on-screen prompts to set these up.
- 5. Search for your department by Region you are associated with (see notes below)
- 6. Once you are logged in, a Terms and Conditions page will appear. Read and acknowledge the agreement to continue to EpicCare Link.

Next Steps After Logging In

- 7. Verify your demographics in Menu, Settings, My Demographics. Update, as needed.
- 8. If you are a Site Coordinator, please verify your facility demographics, as well: Admin, My Facilities. Update, as needed.
- 9. Set up your notification preferences: Menu, Settings, Notification Preferences
- 10. Set up your Event Monitor Settings: Menu, Settings, Event Settings

Important Notes Regarding Log In Activities

- With two factor authentication, some phone carriers will disenroll you
 automatically from receiving text notifications. If you chose "text" as your two
 factor authentication method and do not receive the code within 30 seconds,
 please text TRINITYMYC to 622622, and try again. This will opt you in to receive
 these text notifications, which is our recommended method. You may need to
 do this again if you get a new phone or carrier.
- Upon logging in, you may check the box "keep me logged in", which will save your two factor authentication for 24 hours. You will still need to log in with your user name and password but will not need the authentication code after your initial log in. After 24 hours, you will have to authenticate again



- Your department should always be the Region in which you are associated with, which should automatically default. If it does not, please search for one of the following:
- TH LINK SE MI ST JOSEPH MERCY HEALTH SYSTEM EXTERNAL COMMUNITY
- TH LINK W MI MERCY HEALTH EXTERNAL COMMUNITY
- TH LINK NY ST PETERS HEALTH PARTNERS EXTERNAL COMMUNITY

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How do I log out?
