MENTAL HEALTH/ FAMILY COUNSELING

This is not a complete list, but includes many contacts that other patients have frequently used. To determine what services and which providers are covered, we recommend reaching out to your child's insurance company.

A neuropsychological or psychoeducational evaluation is typically performed by a psychologist (PhD) while only a psychiatrist (MD, DO, NP or PA) can prescribe medication. Counseling/therapy can be performed by many different providers including psychiatrists, psychologists and licensed therapists, counselors and social workers. Some offices may provide all of these services while others are more specific. We recommend calling multiple practices as there can often be wait lists and sometimes long wait times.
